- ◆ Monitor how ICT is used in ITE courses to:
 - understand how training in the use of ICT is integrated in different countries
 - identify innovative approaches to incorporating ICT training (both technical and pedagogical) in courses for student teachers
 - explore new models for ITE delivery, including within 'teaching schools'
- ◆ Define competencies for newly qualified teachers and teacher educators
- ◆ Adapt existing CPD resources for use by student teachers
- ◆ Develop MOOCs for student teachers to drive change in ITE institutions that are slow to reform curricula
- ◆ Establish MoE/industry/H.E. forum to help mainstream project results in ITE

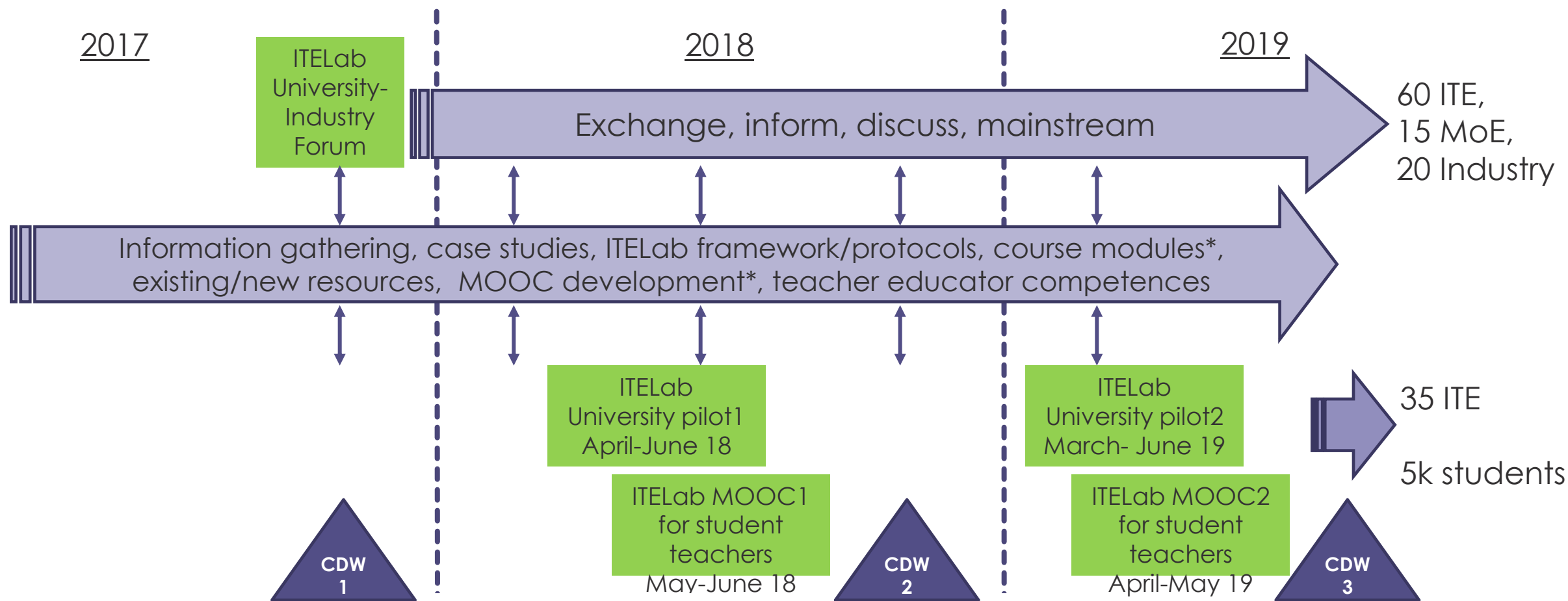

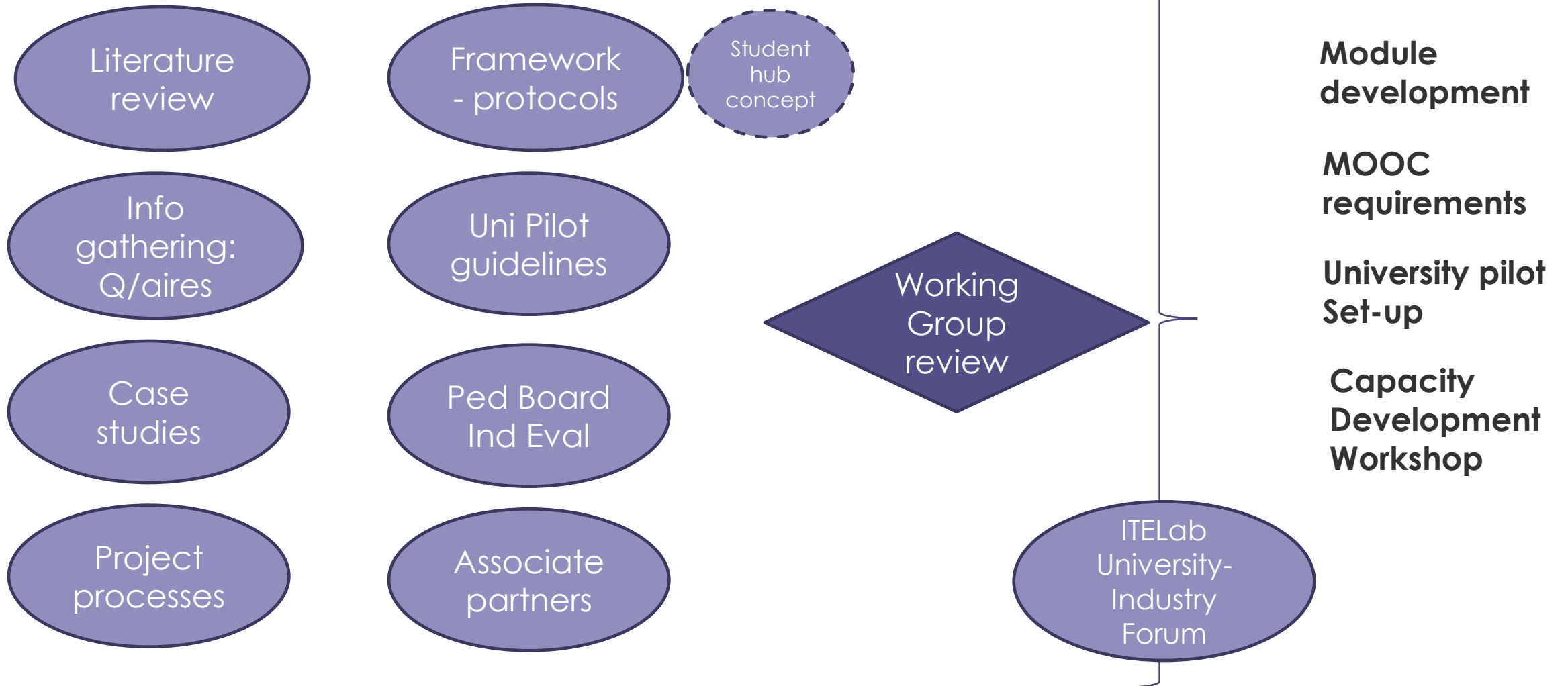
